

ORDINANCE 1428

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE, CALIFORNIA AMENDING TITLE 18.04 AND 18.96 OF THE MARYSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE TO REMOVE THE FIVE HUNDRED-FOOT SPACING REQUIREMENT FOR SERVICE STATIONS EXCEPT IN THE MEDICAL ARTS DISTRICT.

The City Council of the City of Marysville, State of California, does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Section 18.04.370 entitled "Service Station" is hereby amended to read as follows (corrections **bolded** and in **red**, deletions have been ~~struck~~):

*"Service station" means a retail business establishment supplying motor fuel and/or oil.*

Section 2: Section 18.96.050 entitled "Service Station Performance Standards" is hereby amended to read as follows (corrections **bolded** and in **red**, deletions have been ~~struck~~):

*All service stations shall comply with the following performance standards:*

*(a) No visible oil drainage pit or appliance for any such purpose other than filling caps shall be located within twelve feet of any public right-of-way or within twenty-five feet of any R district, except where such pit or appliance is within a building.*

*(b) Open storage of materials and equipment, including rental trailers, shall be permitted only within an area surrounded and screened by a solid wall or fence not less than six feet in height.*

*(c) The minimum distance between service station sites shall be five hundred feet **within the Medical Arts District**. (Ord. 1292 § 1 (part), 2005).*

Section 3

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from and after its passage. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause copies of this ordinance to be posted in three (3) prominent places in the City of Marysville within fifteen (15) days after the adoption of the ordinance.
