City Manager Holds Public Workshop on the City's FY 2018/2019 Budget

MARYSVILLE, CA (May 28, 2018)—On Thursday, May 31 at 6:00 pm at 723 D Street in Marysville, the Marysville City Manager will hold a public workshop on the proposed Fiscal Year 2018/2019 budget.

“I look forward to sharing this year’s proposed budget with the community. Thanks to voter approved Measure C (passed in 2016), there has been an upturn in City revenues allowing the City to offer improved services and projects to the community,” commented Marti Brown, Marysville City Manager.

The presentation will focus on this past year’s City revenues and expenditures and proposed new expenditures for the 2018/2019 budget, as well as trends in the State, regional and local economies.

When asked to comment on the new budget, Police Chief Sachs added: “I’m excited about the upcoming budget, because it gives us the opportunity to provide additional services to the citizens of Marysville.”

Community Development & Services Director, Jim Bermudez, ended city staff comments by saying, “The proposed budget lays the groundwork for a multi-year plan to restore city services that make our neighborhoods more livable including reinvesting in our parks and recreation, infrastructure such as roads and sidewalks, and ensuring the delivery of high quality projects and services that matter most to residents.”
